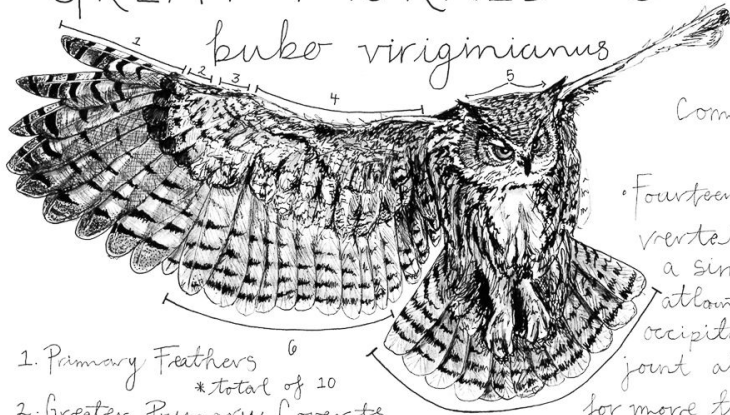
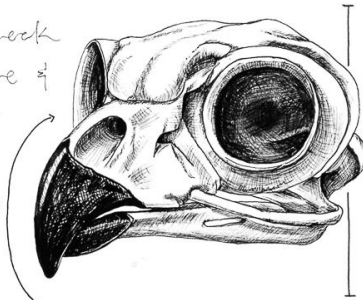


# GREAT HORNED OWL

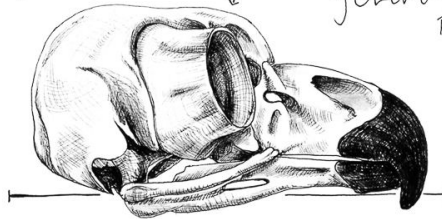


• Eyes are elongated & tube-shaped, making them completely immobile.

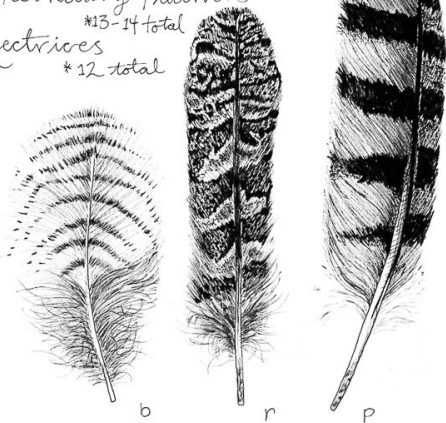
• Fourteen neck vertebrae & a single atlanto-occipital joint allows for more than 180 degrees of neck rotation.
